

SECONDARY UNIFORMS

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Formal uniform:

Formal uniforms should be worn on the first and last day of term, and when requested (representing the school, performances, concerts, etc.).

Formal uniform is navy blue dress pants with a black belt, or a navy blue skirt/skort.

A plain white button down shirt, tucked in, with an Island Academy tie.

Black polishable dress shoes, with black or white socks.

Normal uniform:

Navy blue dress pants or shorts with a black belt, or a navy blue skirt/skort. Shorts and skirts must come to 2 inches above the knee or longer.

Island Academy white polo shirt, tucked in.

Black polishable dress shoes, with black or white socks.

PE uniform:

Plain navy blue sports short (loose). No tights permitted. Shorts must come to 2 inches above the knee or longer. Island Academy white PE shirt.

Sneakers/trainers with white or black socks.

Optional Items: IA navy blue sweater.

Details:

Jewelry is not permitted at Island Academy. Students are permitted to wear a watch (not smart), and one pair of plain stud earrings in their ears.

Nail polish of any kind is not permitted.

Hair must be tied up. Accessories must be functional, not aesthetic, and should not protrude from the head (e.g. large bows or headbands with attachments).
